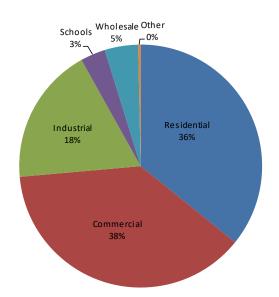

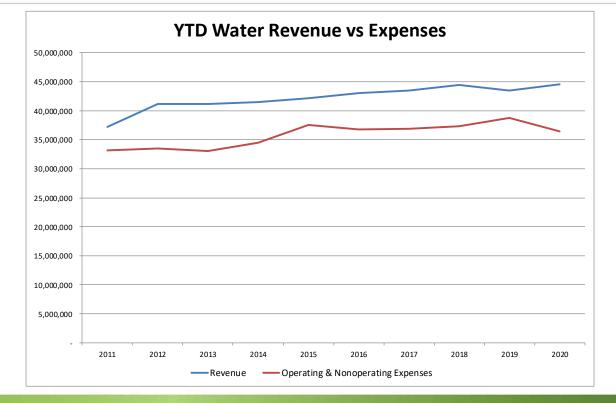


Financial Results – 10 Year Trend
